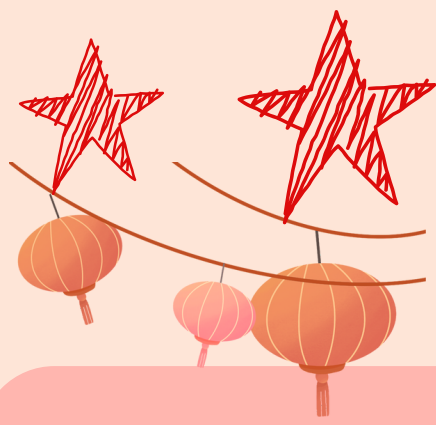
Swimming Carnival
